

Event Safety Guidelines

Event Safety Guidelines (in accordance with CDC, WHO):

- At-risk populations are discouraged from attending events.
- Event goers and participants who begin to exhibit any symptoms of COVID-19 - which include fever, cough, and shortness of breath - must leave the event.



Support for Field Staff:

- Each staff member will be provided with a disposable face mask, a pair of gloves and hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol as per the CDC (or be reimbursed for these items if they provide their own).
- Staff members will either be provided with disinfectant, or be reimbursed if they provide their own.
- Note: staff members who are at risk or exhibiting symptoms will be prohibited from working events (and asked to leave if already on site).



Event Safety Guidelines


Do's:

- Clean frequently touched surfaces and objects with detergent and water prior to disinfection, especially surfaces that are visibly dirty.
- Keep a 6-foot distance from others at all times, including other staff members.
- Limit the number of people to engage with (maximum two people at a time).
- Faces masks (that cover nose and mouth) and gloves must be worn at all times.
- Wash hands and change gloves when dirty.



Don'ts:

- Do not make physical contact with anyone, including other staff members, as this would break social distancing.
- Do not for any reason remove PPE (masks, gloves).
- Do not make contact when handing or receiving anything to/from another person.
